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1.3 <u>Minutes of Previous Meeting</u>

1.4 Safeguarding

JS read a note from CPS about recent updates to safeguarding policy to close previous gaps. PCC agreed to regularly review the policy and keep safeguarding as an important issue that may be raised wherever anyone has a concern. JS highlighted that C2 training would no longer be required for little church leaders as it was identified as not being necessary for these leaders.

MH pointed out typo - p23 of policy doc 'exportation'.

The adoption of this new Safeguarding Policy - 2023 was then

2 Vision and Strategy

JS shared updates regarding vision and strategy - B&A has a heart to serve the large areas of Bristol that are underserved by churches (churches outside the centre/central north of Bristol). JP shared his experience of helping at St Agnes church and how this could be replicated by others elsewhere. JS clarified that this vision is to work with churches across the denominations. The main reason for partnerships is working churches with a heart for evangelism and serving their communities. PCC discussed the sorts of churches they'd like to partner with, and what reasons there might be for not partnering with them. JS shared that this vision could even involve one day sending members of B&A to help church plant with other churches in the areas in which they live. This vision has been defined as 'Bringing Bristol to Jesus'.

WB asked what coordination there is with other large churches in Bristol with similar missions. JS is trusting the spirit to guide us, alongside conversation with other churches, particularly other LYN hubs. JS and RC shared we can partner in unique ways and are not trying to compete with current offerings and work by other churches (e.g. by offering meals).

3	Budget	
3.1	WB provided update regarding budget and recent offering. This shows expenditure is still above forecast income and levels of giving are not as high as one might expect for church of our size and demographic.	
	Parish share forecast to be £135k. Diocese has requested £142k. Suggestion to pay quarterly not monthly.

4	Building update	
4.1	JP provided building update. Two faculties approved since last meeting. Maintenance work, structuring work, including roof undergo. Finances do not currently allow us to do everything we wish to with the building.	
4.2	JS shared plan for park site. The garden site is proving difficult to sell due to disagreement with diocese. We now know that we do not own the church building itself - this is owned by diocese. JS shared plan to combine plot with hall and bring both to market. A couple of Christian organisations have shown interest in buying the hall and bringing to market may accelerate this and highlight the opportunity to others.
